Alberta has approximately six billion tonnes of coal reserves, nine coal mines, and 18 coal-fired power plants. Under existing federal regulation, 12 of the power plants will be shut down or placed on standby by 2029 and the remaining six would reach end of life between 2030 and 2061. Alberta's Climate Leadership Plan includes an accelerated approach which would shut down all coal fired plants by 2030. This AUMA webinar will feature Robin Campbell, President of the Coal Association of Canada.
