Detachment Staffing Levels

- **Evansburg is staffed by 1 Sgt – 1 Cpl and 6 Constables and 2 PS positions**
 - All positions are currently full.
 - Fleet was upgraded to and additional vehicle which now includes an unmarked police vehicle.
 - In house VSU no longer in place currently based out of Drayton.



Community Priorities continued

- **Visibility Patrols goal of 600**
 - currently at the end of our 4th quarter, we were at 624 of 600.
- **Prolific Offenders goal of 60 compliance checks**
 - Currently at the end of our 4th quarter, we were at 69 of 60.
 - 4 search warrants granted, 4 tracking orders and multiple financial orders targeting fraudsters.



Community Priorities continued

- **Community Relations and Education**
 - 7 of 6 fraud seminars to our seniors were put on. Lots of engagement from our community. Goal has been met.
 - Leadership seminar to our Army Cadets
 - Skating with the wildwood youth, serving food in the schools.
 - Town halls focusing on getting the public to call in anything suspicious.



Community Priorities continued

- **SCAN team**
 - Has been utilized to assist in targeting problem houses. - ongoing
- **District CRU (Crime Reduction unity)**
 - Helped track and target our criminals bouncing between jurisdictions in our district. (prolific offenders)
 - Have also provided training to my staff on tracking warrants, drug investigations



Community Priorities continued

- **Provincial Crime Reduction team (CRT)**
 - Helped us target individuals that have been coming from outside our district such as Edmonton. (prolific offenders)
 - Bait Vehicle utilized to target vehicle thieves in the area.

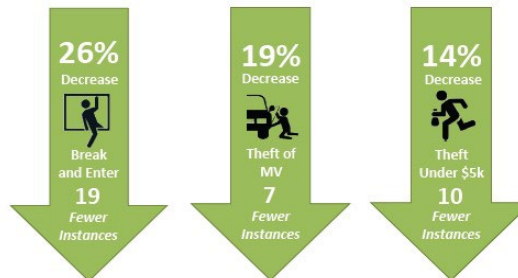

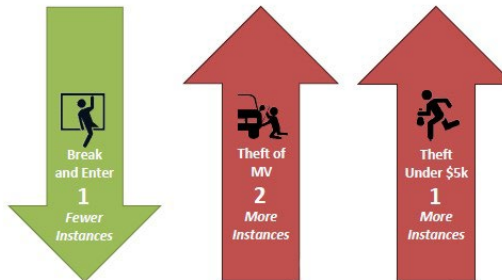
2026 vs. 2025

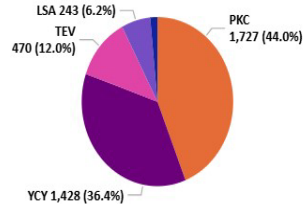

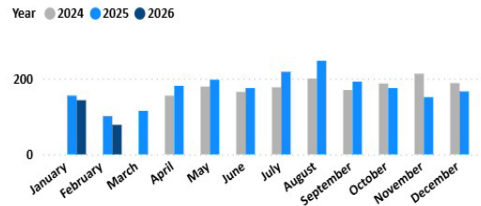

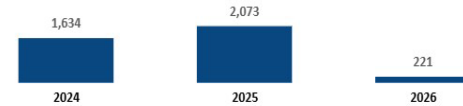
File Counts by Zone



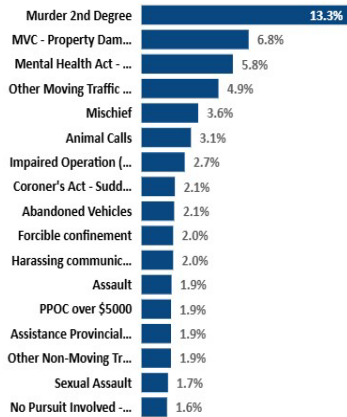
File Counts by Month



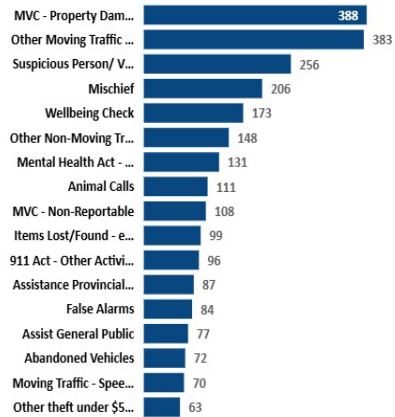
File Counts by Year

2026 – 2027 Community Priority Plan

- **Consultation through community partners town halls.**
- **Request was to continue from last years plan.**
- **One crime trend that popped up in March during patrols, a noted jump up in Impaired drivers.**



2026 – 2027 Community Priority Plan Visibility

- **Track patrols in rural area.**
 - Last year was a goal of 600 – (Evansburg and Entwistle were not tracked, just rural areas)
 - This year the goal will be 1000 but Entwistle and Evansburg will be added to the tracking list.
 - Goal is to target traveling criminals and impaired drivers while maintaining our drop in rural property crime



2026 – 2027 Community Priority Plan Traffic Safety

- **8 Joint check stops**
 - With the noted increase in impaired driver's members will conduct 8 joint operations with our partners with a focus on impaired drivers
 - First has already been set up for May with Parkland CPO's, RCMP, and Sherrif's
 - Goal is to lower the number of Impaired located by members on patrols



2026 – 2027 Community Priority Plan Community Education

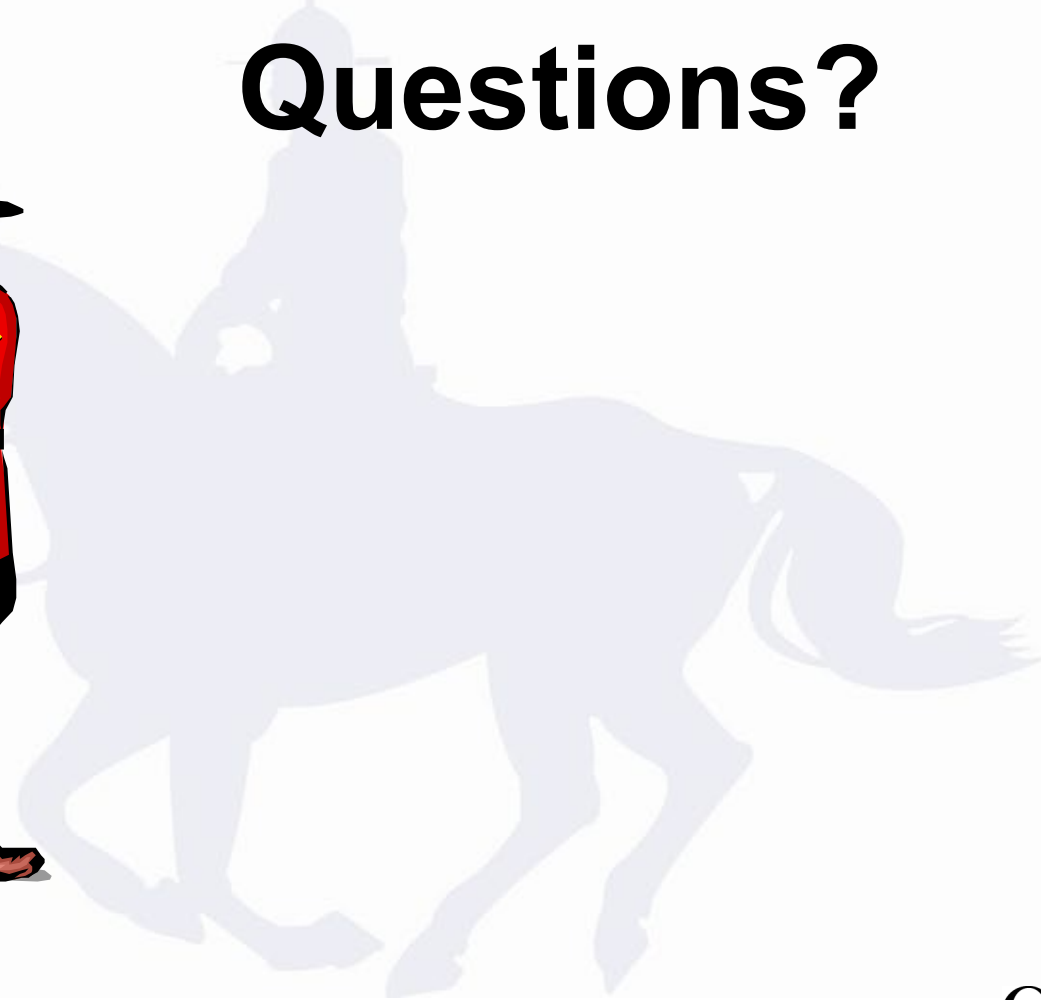
- **Fraud is still a hot button topic, especially with the advances in AI**
