

COME ALIVE ENTWISTLE PROJECT BEAUTIFICATION COMPONENT

Benches

- * Main street – post office, outside Seniors Centre, and in front of the grocery store
- * Park Area - Area across from community hall in playground and at Skateboard park
- * Trail system – located at pivotal points on trail system as deemed appropriate

Banners

- * Multiple Season banners to depict the spring, summer, fall and winter season
- * located on main street, down to the park area on Hwy 16A , on the south side of the highway in front of the businesses

Garbage Cans

- * Strategically placed throughout the community that are aesthetically pleasing in combination with recycling components

Flowers/Metal Art Work

- * New Container Pots to be located in areas near businesses (business people to look after the flowers planted)
- * Hanging baskets plus stand alone in container pots (hanging baskets along Hwy 16A and main street) We are also looking at the possibility of hanging metal art work instead of flowers for a more maintenance free project

Graffiti Art

- * Hire or commission a graffiti artist to work with the youth and parents as we make the skateboard park area come alive. Have the students from the Entwistle and outlying area work with the artists and with the assistance of the RCMP (already spoken to the Sgt and she will ensure that there is RCMP representation) and hopefully someone from the fire department.

Trail System/ Signage

- * Benches located strategically within the Trail System plus gravel (approval permitting) the Entwistle side of the trail system located on the Provincial Park property
- * Welcome to the Hamlet of Entwistle signage as well as signage within the community
