Why a "review"

- Passed in 2009
- Dynamic document
- Ensures it is enforceable and effective in its application
- Will respond to development trends, community interest, and County's strategic direction



Three-Phased Approach

Phase I (Birds Eye View)

- High level corrections
- Minor formatting
- Improved criteria & direction

3 to 4 Months

Phase II (Eye Level)

- Structural and Formatting Changes
- Address more significant issues

4 to 6 Months

Phase III

(Ground Level)

Regulatory
 Changes to
 Specific Uses
 and
 Developments

10 to 14 Months
