Connectivity

- Next phase of Connectivity is to create a 'network' utilizing existing towers and new fibre.
- 2. Partnering with O-Net to build two pilot projects:

1. Entwistle Aerial Fibre Pilot 2. Rolling Heights Backhaul to Fibre Pilot

3. Partnering with O-Net to create a County, and overall network strategy fibre strategy.







Connectivity

- Bell fibre to Acheson Fire Hall with interconnection to Acheson Tower and backhaul to County Centre. For October; creation of a second Point-Of-Presence (or mini-POP for Internet providers)
- IT is connecting the other County Facilities; current site is the transfer station. The internet into that site will eliminate the use of expensive aircards



- Moving forward with the Community Hall/ Public Hotspot project

-Spruce Grove, Stony Plain and Carvel markets have agreed tobe drop off locations for vendors as well as promote the site






