On 2016/08/06 at 0741 hrs. Peace Officer BACKSTROM observed a gravel truck enter onto RRD 35 south of Hwy 627. The truck was operating for Mixcor Aggregates. The haul times for a Saturday is 0800 hrs. The truck was on the haul route prior to the permitted haul times. The driver, [REDACTED] was issued an immediate 1 day suspension from the haul. Mixcor Aggregates will also be issued a 1 day haul agreement suspension.

INVESTIGATION

2016/08/06

- At 0741 hrs. Peace Officer BACKSTROM was travelling west on Hwy 627 approaching RRD 35.
- BACKSTROM observed a black truck tractor with a white semi trailer, gravel truck entering onto RRD 35 from Hwy 627.
- BACKSTROM conducted a traffic stop on the gravel truck.
- The truck was a [REDACTED] displaying an Alberta Licence plate [REDACTED].
- The truck was pulling a [REDACTED] trailer displaying an Alberta Licence plate [REDACTED].
- The truck was displaying an Alberta Sand & Gravel Association (ASGA) number [REDACTED].
- The driver was identified by means of an Alberta Operator's Licence as [REDACTED].
- [REDACTED] confirmed he was going to the Mixcor Aggregates pit on RRD 35.
- BACKSTROM advised [REDACTED] that trucks are not permitted on the haul road prior to 0800 hrs.
- [REDACTED] stated he did not know this.
- BACKSTROM asked how long [REDACTED] has been hauling for Mixcor Aggregates.
- [REDACTED] did not reply.
- Mixcor Aggregates currently holds Haul Agreement No. 2015-H-45.
- Sec. 16 of the Haul Agreement states the hours of operation for hauling shall be:
8:00 am to 4:00 pm on Saturday.

- There is no provision to allow trucks to enter onto the road prior to the permitted start time.
- Sec. 18 of the Haul Agreement states the penalties for the infractions.
- The penalty for truck movements before approved times or designated haul periods for first offence is truck and driver suspended for one day and haul agreement suspended for one day.
- BACKSTROM issued [REDACTED] an immediate one day suspension to be served on todays date.
- That suspension was issued via Parkland County Gravel Pit/Truck Investigational Report No. 028.
- BACKSTROM attended the Mixcor Aggregates pit and spoke with the scale operator, [REDACTED]
- BACKSTROM advised [REDACTED] that truck 8818 was on the road outside of the hours and was issued a 1 day suspension.
- BACKSTROM also advised there will be a one day Haul Agreement suspension issued to Mixcor Aggregates.
- BACKSTROM advised he will complete the Haul Agreement suspension letter and drop it off either Monday or Tuesday.
