Members of the Alberta Forest Products Association (AFPA) planted 74 million tree seedlings in Alberta's forests during the 2016 planting season. This means that for every Albertan, 18 trees were planted this spring and summer. The industry replants an average of 2 trees for every 1 that is harvested.
