## POLICY STATEMENT

Street lighting may be considered for installation within the County.

## POLICY

All street lighting requests shall require the approval of Council and shall meet the requirements for location and sharing of costs as outlined below:

1. Street lighting will be considered within or at the following locations:
  - Recognized hamlets
  - County facilities
  - Country Residential subdivisions
  - Industrial Parks
  - Major road intersections or locations identified as requiring lighting for safety considerations.
2. Street lighting within Industrial Parks and Country Residential subdivisions will only be considered provided the developer pays the capital cost of street light installation, or the benefiting land owners pay for the capital costs through a local improvement charge or direct payment.
3. The energy costs for all approved street lights within Industrial Parks and Country Residential subdivisions shall be paid for by the County.
4. The County shall determine when street lights are to be energized.
5. Any related capital costs and/or energy costs for street lights located in hamlets, County facilities and specifically identified locations will be covered by the County unless identified to be paid for by adjacent land owners or developers.
6. The County may consider cost-sharing the energy cost of street lighting with another jurisdiction where the street lighting provides a common benefit to both jurisdictions.

## PROCEDURE

All requests for streetlighting shall be made in writing to the General Manager of Corporate Services and shall require the approval of Council.
