# CN to purchase 350 lumber cars to meet growing demand in forest products business

HAMILTON, Ont., May 2, 2018 — CN (TSX: CNR) (NYSE: CNI) today announced it will buy 350 centrebeam cars to serve growing demand from lumber producing customers across its North American network. The new-build, 73-foot riserless centrebeams, with a maximum load capacity of 286,000 pounds, are expected to be delivered starting in September. CN is also looking at an option to purchase or lease an additional 300 cars.
