- One of 7 library systems
- Established in 1971
- 54 municipalities
- 3 school divisions
- 290,000+ served
- Parkland County joined in 1971

#### Governance

- Public Libraries Act and Regulations
- Master Membership Agreement
- Board of Trustees: appointed by each municipality and school division
- Executive
  - Elected by the Board
  - Full governance power, with exceptions

#### Revenue

- Master Membership Agreement Schedule C
  - 2018: \$4.30 per capita
  - 2019: \$4.30 per capita
- Based on most recent population figure for the municipality from Alberta Municipal Affairs
- Parkland County: \$138,017 (2019)
- Operating grant from Public Library Services Branch based on 2016 population

#### **Collection Development and Support:**

- Materials allotment: \$0.75 per capita
  - 2018 Allotment to Parkland County: \$6,018.20
- Cataloguing and processing of material
- Material delivery
  - Duffield, Entwistle, Keephills and Tomahawk each receive one delivery per week of new material and interlibrary loan requests from TRAC libraries or other libraries in the province


