## **TRI-COUNTY AGRICULTURE BUSINESS STUDY**

### **Project Description**

The Tri-County Agriculture Business Study will identify best suited agri-business, better coordinate collective efforts to attract value-add and food processing businesses and investments in the sector, and identify the service requirements for support.

### Schedule

• Project anticipated to conclude August 30<sup>th</sup>

### Budget

- \$97,850 Alberta Community Partnership (ACP) Grant
- \$76,883 spent as of August 5, 2020

### **Project Risk**

 COVID-19 schedule impacts have been largely mitigated – an additional month was added to the schedule without compromising the integrity of the project



## **TRI-COUNTY AG COMMUNICATION PLAN**

### **Project Description**

The Tri-County Ag Communication Plan includes the development of a communications plan with specific strategies focused on raising awareness of the contributions of the agricultural sector to the Alberta economy.

### **Current Status**

- Communication Plan complete
- Meeting is scheduled with Sturgeon and Leduc Counties to discuss next steps

### Budget

- \$51,000 Alberta Community Partnership (ACP) Grant
- \$26,800.18 spent as of July 28, 2020

## MERIDIAN BUSINESS PARK FEASIBILITY STUDY

## **Project Description**

The Meridian Business Park Feasibility Study will assess the lands in the area designated as Meridian Business Park to determine development scenarios and associated feasibility.

- \$57,593.37 as of July 28, 2020

### POWER COMMUNITY GENERATION FEASIBILITY STUDY

### **Project Description**

The Power Community Generation Feasibility Study will determine opportunities for development and expansion against associated costs and risks relative to safe and local food supply within Parkland County.

### Schedule

- Final report was received August 5, 2020
- Project completed

### Budget

- \$49,580 Coal Community Transition Fund (CCTF) Grant
- \$33,053.34 spent as of August 18, 2020

## **IRRIGATION FEASIBILITY STUDY**

### **Project Description**

The Irrigation Feasibility Study will determine opportunities for development and expansion against costs and risks for irrigation within Parkland County.

### Schedule

• Project anticipated to conclude by November 2020

### Budget

- \$129,750 Coal Community Transition Fund (CCTF) Grant
- \$45,855.00 spent as of August 17, 2020

**Project Risk** 

 Delay due to COVID-19 affecting access to provincial information required to complete the project



## **SMALL AGRICULTURE HOLDINGS**

### **Project Description**

This project will complete a viability scan for small agriculture holdings to identify opportunities for the development that align with current legislation and regulations.

## Schedule

- Project commenced August 17, 2020
- Project completion anticipated October 31, 2020

## Budget

- \$20,000 Coal Community Transition Fund (CCTF) Grant
  Project Risk
- Was delayed due to internal capacity



### **BRANDING AND MARKETING PLAN AND** IMPLEMENTATION

#### **Project Description**

The Branding and Marketing Plan and Implementation will develop and implement an external marketing strategy focused on economic development and diversification.

#### Schedule

- On Track
- Project anticipated to conclude by Q1 2021

#### **Current Status**

- Phase 1: Research and Phase 2: Planning completed
- 5 sector media campaign is being executed
- Phase 3 : Implementation Plan is underway

#### Budget

- Total: \$476,400
  - \$154,000 matching grant from Western Economic Diversification for a total of \$308,000
  - \$100,000 from Coal Community Transition Fund (CCTF)
  - \$68,400 from Parkland County Branding Initiative Project
- \$305,500 spent as of July 28, 2020

#### **Project Risk**

• COVID-19 will impact execution schedule substantially and Conway has been asked to prepare scheduling alternatives. Planned execution has to include travel i.e. media tours, site selectors – seasonal timing is important.



## **CFO DIVISION REVIEW**

#### **Project Description**

The CFO Division Review includes reporting accuracy, reporting efficiency, and business process optimization.

#### Schedule

• Project anticipated to conclude by Q4 2020

#### **Current Status**

- Identified possible opportunities for simplifying cleanup of data and reports that meets regulatory and Council requirements
- Complete discovery
- Finalize first cut of new reporting and new chart of accounts design

#### Budget

- \$250,000
- \$74,000 spent as of June 30, 2020

#### **Project Risk**

• Staff working remote



#### **Project Description**

• Joint initiative between Parkland County, Spruce Grove, and Stony Plain to identify opportunities to better coordinate planning, operations, and governance.

#### Goal

- To support focused and coordinated investment, planning and development, efficient service delivery, relationship development, and governance where applicable.
  - -Leverage resources and expertise
  - -Reduce financial costs to ratepayers
  - -Minimize environmental impacts

### Three pillars

- Governance
- Plans and Strategies  $\rightarrow$  single, consolidated report
- Implementation





## Schedule

• April 1, 2019 to September 30, 2021

## Budget

- \$2.2 million Western Economic Diversification Contribution Agreement
- \$200K Parkland County contribution

## **Project Risks**

• Large project with significant resource requirements at the executive and operational levels of three municipalities
