## PURPOSE

The purpose of this policy is to ensure that an effective orientation plan is developed prior to every general municipal election. <u>(Refer to Council Code of Conduct Bylaw 2018-05, Municipal Government Act, and Code of Conduct for Elected Officials Regulation 200/2017)</u>

## POLICY STATEMENT

Parkland County shall provide Council orientation to newly elected and re-elected members of Council after every general municipal election and by-election. <u>(Refer to Council Code of Conduct Bylaw 2018-05, Municipal Government Act, and Code of Conduct for Elected Officials Regulation 200/2017)</u>

## RESPONSIBILITIES

Legislative and Administrative Services is responsible for the development, implementation, monitoring and evaluating of this policy.

## STANDARDS

- 1. Council orientation shall include an overview of:
  - Roles, responsibilities, and duties under the Municipal Government Act,
  - Working relationships with Administration and the County's governance structure,
  - County bylaws, policies, strategic plans, and current issues facing the County,
  - A framework to begin strategic planning in order to set direction, priorities, and corporate objectives for the term.
- 2. Additional training or information workshops may be scheduled on an ongoing basis, or when requested by Council.
- 3. Administration may present a Council Orientation Plan to Council as information before every general municipal election.
