PURPOSE

To aid in sustainability of cultivated land within the County.

POLICY STATEMENT

Where a Soil Conservation Officer finds or determines that cultivated land in the County is, or is becoming, impoverished through wind or water erosion, or any other cause that has affected or may seriously affect the productivity of the land or the welfare of the owner or occupant of the land, and may become a menace to the community, appropriate action shall be taken in accordance with the requirements of the *Soil Conservation Act*.

SCOPE

Applies to all cultivated land in Parkland County.

MANAGEMENT RESPONSIBILITIES

The Manager of Agricultural Services shall be responsible for implementing and monitoring this policy.
