## 3D Concept Option 1:








- A 4' Quarter Pipe + Hip



## **3D** Concept Option 3:



This preliminary 3D Option is based on feedback from the community received during an online workshop and survey. The results of the survey have shown a clear direction towards transition style features. Option 3 uses a symmetrical theme, dividing the skatespot into two. One side being transition with clean, straight lines. While the other side uses angles to create street style transition features. Separating these two halves is an organic flow area with lots of elevation change and smooth rollers.
