Wendel Place Road Surfacing Petition Report

Proposed Motion

That the Wendel Place road surfacing petition report be accepted for information, as presented.

Administration Recommendation

Administration supports the proposed motion.

Purpose

To fulfill the Chief Administrative Officer's responsibility to report to Council on the sufficiency of the petition.

Summary

The Wendel Place petition is sufficient and meets the requirements of the *Municipal Government Act of Alberta* and Parkland County Country Residential Road Surfacing Policy EN 001.

Strategic Plan/Policy/Legal/Staff Implications

Sections 224 and 225 of the *Municipal Government Act* provide the legislated requirements for a petition and the counting of petitioners. Section 226 of the *MGA* compels the Chief Administrative Officer to make a report to Council on the sufficiency of a petition.

Country Residential Road Surfacing Policy EN 001 lets administration consider the surfacing of roadways in a residential subdivision where development has occurred on at least 50% of the properties, and residents submit a sufficient petition that is signed by at least 2/3 of the property owners that hold at least 1/2 the value of property assessments for that subdivision.
