Due to a variety of scope changes, and some additional circumstances outside of our control, the project has taken longer than anticipated. However, the process was a thorough one which included a very detailed public engagement plan, providing multiple opportunities and methods for input from residents, stakeholder groups, staff and Council.

Should Council accept the Plan as presented, Administration would begin to develop an implementation strategy for consideration and decision through the Strategic Planning and Budget process.
